In addition to clinic and hospital services, the candidate will provide after-hours, on-call coverage. Call Coverage is shared with a very patient-centered and cooperative call group of 6 Physicians within the specialty and an on-call premium is provided for on-call availability.

Prince Albert is located over the geographic centre of Saskatchewan. It is the largest centre in the region with a population of 45,000.
