



## Obstetrician/Gynecologist Eastern Health

Eastern Regional Health Authority (EH) and the Women's Health Program invites expressions of interest for a full-time fee for service Obstetrician / Gynecologist.

The successful applicant will work within an interdisciplinary team to provide full scope Obstetrics / Gynecology services in the community and at the Health Sciences Centre which is the tertiary Obstetrical center for the province. Duties will include participation in the on-call service for Obstetrics, operating room time for Gynecology and one half day a week of hospital gynecology clinic. The successful applicant will be responsible for establishing their own private office in the area to see patients. On-call coverage is required and shared equitably within the group approximately 3-4 on-call/month.

HSC is a teaching hospital affiliated with the Faculty of Medicine at Memorial University affording opportunities for research and teaching. Academic responsibilities will be consistent with part time academic faculty at MUN and will include doing teach rounds, resident education and medical student education as determined by the department.

To be considered candidates must hold a medical degree and have successfully completed a residency in obstetrics / gynecology and be eligible for Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada Certification (or equivalent). Subspecialty training is considered an asset. Fetal heart surveillance course is a requirement. Additionally applicants must be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Newfoundland and Labrador.
