Multiple Choice Question Working Group

Terms of Reference

PURPOSE

To develop, review and update multiple choice questions for the resident practice exam.

OBJECTIVES

- 1. Write multiple choice questions that span the different specialty areas for the resident practice exam.
- 2. Review existing questions in the question bank on an annual basis.
- 3. Use feedback from faculty and residents about the questions to improve the quality of questions.

WORKING GROUP COMPOSITION

The working group will be composed of SOGC members with demonstrated and established expertise in Medical Education.

- The working group should be composed of obstetrician/gynaecologists with expertise in creating multiple choice questions. It shall be broad-based and reflect the diversity of the practice.
- Strong consideration should be given to representation from each of the 5 SOGC regions (West: BC/AB, Central: MB/SK/NT/YN, Ontario, Quebec, Atlantic: NB/NS/PE/NL) and/or the relevant specialty areas (maternal-fetal medicine, gynaecological oncology, genetics, infectious disease, diagnostic imaging, etc.)
- Representative of the Postgraduate Education Working Group of the Academic Council (Chair).

TERMS

2, 3 or 4 years in the initial year, and 3 years in the years thereafter, renewable once.

QUORUM

Quorum is defined as 50% + 1 of working group members.

MEETINGS

vorking group should hold a minimum of one virtual/face-to-face meeting and a number of onferences as determined by the Chair (suggested minimum is three).

ctivities of the working group will take place on an ongoing basis throughout the year.

vorking group chair (or designate) will be required to attend the Chairs meeting held during nnual Clinical and Scientific Conference.

EXPECTATIONS

Members must be an SOGC member in good standing.

Members must attend 75% of the working group meetings.
